

JOB DESCRIPTION - Field Service Technician

The field service technician will provide assistance with installation, troubleshooting, repairs and maintenance of water treatment equipment at multiple customer locations. The key responsibilities of the field service technician are to effectively assist with identifying problems as they occur and take appropriate steps to solve them, including performing repair or referring more complex issues to management. We understand that a successful business needs quality employees. Detailed Job Description:

- 1. Perform routine maintenance (i.e. filter changes, DI/Carbon exchanges, RO cleanings, and sanitizations) on water treatment systems at customer facilities. DI & Carbon tanks can weigh 50-300 lbs. Technician must be able to follow instructions on drawings, manuals and standard operating procedures. Individual will also need to use different tools (pallet jack, adjustable wrenches, pipe cutters, etc.) for daily work. Handcart is provided for tanks and materials weighing 50 lbs. or more.
- 2. Operates company vehicles. Technician needs to keep vehicle, tools and parts in a neat and orderly fashion. Individual will also perform daily safety checks of vehicle, keep daily driving log and ensure that vehicle is kept in good operating condition.
- 3. Troubleshoot and repair water treatment equipment. Including leak repairs, equipment replacement and instrument calibrations.
- 4. Completes required information on service orders (resistivity & meter readings, batch #'s for all tanks) and other documentation in professional and neat manner. Understands and practices good customer relations and exhibits proper behavior at all times.
- 5. Can describe operation of water systems to customer, actively participates in both administering and receiving technical training. Individual will be expected to be proficient in mechanical plumbing skills, water chemistry, membrane chemistry, maintenance and working knowledge of electrical and control principles of company supplied systems.
- 6. General work hours are 7:30am to 4:00 pm with a willingness to work overtime as required including call out for emergency service outside of normal working hours. Also required to have company provided cell phone and be on call at specified hours. Individual must be dependable, honest and detail oriented.
